

Code of Conduct

Overlook Ladies Golf Association (OLGA)

Golf is a complex game and we must expect the rules to reflect that fact. The purpose of the rules is to insure that as far as possible, everyone plays the same game. Thus, the rules serve as a guide for all players. All players shall conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.

- 1. Competitors will be in violation of this Code of Conduct if they engage in abusive language, club throwing, disrespect of starters, not adhering to the dress code, abusive behavior to employees of Overlook Golf Course, and otherwise failing to conduct themselves in keeping with the game's traditions, which include respect for fellow competitors.
- 2. Proper attire is required at all times primarily dictated by the rules at Overlook Golf Course. (See a. below)
 - a. "Proper attire required at all times. Women's sleeveless shirts with collars are allowed. No tank tops, halter tops, swim tops, gym shorts or gym attire, cutoffs and short shorts are not allowed on the golf course. Soft spikes only".
 - b. Metal spikes are prohibited at Overlook Golf Course.
- 3. USGA rules govern all play.
- 4. USGA slow play will be enforced. (See our Guideline Sheet)
- 5. Distance Measuring Devices The use of distance measuring devices are permissible for all weekly games at Overlook.
